Preparing for SOL Testing...Our spring SOL testing window is quickly approaching for 3rd, 4th, & 5th graders. The following websites are helpful for reviewing, practicing, and preparing for SOL tests: http://guest.portaportal.com/solprep or http://www.doe.virginia.gov/testing/sol/practice items/

SOL Testing...Students in grades 3-5 will participate in the Standards of Learning (SOL) testing during **May 8-June 2, 2017.** It is very important that students are present and on-time to school each day for testing. Please refrain from scheduling medical appointments or family trips during the testing window. Please note that expedited retakes (including remediation and review instruction) will take place throughout the testing window. The state Board of Education only allows for expedited retakes for students who initially do not pass by a narrow margin; not all students will qualify for an expedited retake. Further details regarding each grade level's testing schedule and expedited retakes will be sent home at a later date.

Meal Charges Must be Cleared....

An automated calling system and letters are used to inform parent/guardians of their student's negative cafeteria balance of \$15 or more. To keep your student in good standing, please take steps to clear the amount owed by sending in cash, check, or by utilizing the online payment system, MySchoolBucks, which will be found on the school's webpage.

Students not in good standing may be prevented from participating in certain after school activities.

If you feel you may be eligible for reduced-priced or free meals through the National School Lunch Program, the form can be obtained from the principal at your student's school or downloaded from www.frederick.k12.va.us.

Free and Reduced Meal Program...Frederick County Public Schools are reminding the community of the availability of the Free and Reduced Meal Program. Under the program, both school breakfast and lunch are available each day for free or at a reduced price for eligible students. Eligibility is based on income and applications are accepted at any time. Information on students participating in the Free and Reduced Meal Program is kept private and students who participate are not singled out as they go through the line in the cafeteria. Applications for the Free and Reduced Lunch and Breakfast program are available at the Frederick County Public Schools Administration Building, each Frederick County Public School, and the school division's website (<u>www.frederick.k12.va.us</u>).
