



# STONEWALL ELEMENTARY 20-21 Supply List



Supply lists for each grade at Stonewall Elementary School are included below. While there are many uncertainties about the upcoming school year, we feel that the following supplies will support learning while your children are in the school building. However, it will be important to keep in mind that students will also be engaging in various learning experiences from home. Additional supplies may need to be purchased for students to utilize while working outside of the school setting.

## **KINDERGARTEN**

- Large **zippered** back pack
- 1 standard sized plastic pencil box
- 1 pair of children's scissors
- 1 pair of headphones
- 4 boxes of 24-count crayons
- 1 **polyvinyl** folder with 3 prongs and two pockets
- 8 black expo markers
- 1 pack of markers
- 1 pack of watercolor paints
- 4 large containers of Play-doh
- 1 water bottle with lid (non-spill/flip top)
- 1 box of tissues
- 1 package of baby wipes
- Change of clothing - please place in a ziplock bag labeled with your child's first and last name (shirt, shorts, underwear, socks, shoes-optional)
- Mask/Face covering (strongly recommended)

## **FIRST GRADE**

- 2 marble covered composition notebooks (wide ruled, black)
- 2 boxes of 24-count crayons
- 24 #2 pencils
- 15 Elmer's glue sticks
- 1 pair of blunt tip scissors
- 2 highlighters
- 8 EXPO dry erase markers (blue or black, chisel tip)
- 2 block pink erasers
- 1 pencil box (plastic, standard size)
- 2 boxes of tissues
- 1 pair of headphones or earbuds
- 1 box of plastic bags (**girls-quart; boys-gallon**)
- **optional supplies:**
- 1 pack of watercolor markers

## **SECOND GRADE**

- 2 packs of 12 #2 pencils
- 1 box of 24-count crayons
- 8 **LARGE** glue sticks
- 1 pair of scissors
- 4 **BLACK** dry erase markers (no colors please)
- 1 marble-covered composition books- wide ruled
- 1 plastic pencil box (8 ½ X 5 in.)
- 1 set of headphones or earbuds
- 

## **THIRD GRADE**

- 1 pencil pouch (no boxes please)
- 1 set of headphones (head band type are preferred)
- 4 packs of #2 pencils (mechanical pencils are not preferred))
- 10 glue sticks
- 1 pack of crayons (**24 pack**)
- 1 pair of scissors
- 2 highlighters
- 12 **black** dry erase markers
- 5 marble-covered composition books
- 1 two-pocket folder (plain, basic colors)
- 2 boxes of tissues
- 1 package of baby wipes (**boys only**)
- 1 box of sandwich baggies (**girls only**)
- 2 large erasers

## **FOURTH GRADE**

- 1 pencil pouch - one that zips, no plastic boxes
- 2 packs wide-ruled loose leaf notebook paper
- 3 composition notebooks, 100 ct wide ruled
- 3 plastic folders with prongs and pockets
- 1 pair scissors
- 3 glue sticks (jumbo)
- 6 packages of 12 count #2 pencils (not mechanical)
- 1 box colored pencils or crayons
- 1 pack of markers
- 4 dry erase markers
- 2 highlighters, assorted colors
- 1 box of tissues
- 1 set of headphones

## **FIFTH GRADE\***

- 1 pencil pouch - one that zips, not plastic box.
- 1 pack of colored Pencils, 12 count
- 2-4 packs #2 Ticonderoga pencils, 12 count pre-sharpened if possible. (Preferably not mechanical)
- 2 packs of block erasers (usually pink)
- 1 pair of 5 inch pointed tip scissors
- 2 highlighters, different colors (if possible)
- 8-10 glue sticks, jumbo
- 5 two pocket poly folders, (red, blue, yellow, green, white)
- 6 composition notebooks, 100 ct, wide ruled
- 1 Travel size pack of tissues
- 2 pairs of earbuds or headphones
- 4 black dry erase Expo markers
